Blessing of the Hands ceremony. (Voluntary ceremony)

Evolution of the Blessing of the Hands Ceremony

The evolution of the Blessing of the Hands Ceremony began with Pastor Jack Bomar and Dr. Peter Morgan. Pastor Bomar attended the December 2012 mission trip and Dr. Morgan's objective was to create a ceremony with meaning that the chiropractor, the chiropractic students, and the community would understand and remember. Our blessed hands ceremony was conceived as a spiritual ceremony, rather than a religious ceremony. The initial plan included a ritual hand blessing with oil by the board of Mission Life International. However, Dr. Morgan wished to use a candle in the ceremony such as they use at New Beginnings, Dr. Morgan's candle is lit and then he lights Dr. Dutchman's candle. Dr. Deutchman then lights the knight's candles that light the missionary's candles. When all candles are lit each participant comes up on the stage for the blessing of the hands. The candles represent a worldwide chain of light symbolizing the unity of chiropractors to each other and to their dedication and commitment to human caring.

The ceremony emphasizes the philosophy art and the science of chiropractic and the necessity for chiropractors to provide skilled care with hands guided by their hearts, spirits and innate intelligence. The purposes of the ceremony is bifold:

- 1. To signify that the hands of the doctors and students are truly blessed by God.
- 2. To signify the commencement of being the greatest healers of all time. The ceremony begins with lighting of the Dr. Morgan's Candle, symbolizing the unity of chiropractors and their common commitment to human caring. The same candle is also lit once again at New Beginnings and each chiropractor receives a flame from the New Beginnings flame, thus propagating the chain of light and reminding the chiropractors of their hand dedication ceremony, new beginnings and their commitment to human caring.

The importance of the work of each chiropractors hands within the context of caring is emphasized during the ceremony. The following excerpt is from the text of the ceremony: "It is the hands that God uses as instruments into acts of human caring. The hands guided not only by their new knowledge and skills but also by their spirits and their hearts." Featured in the ceremony are acts of caring as Mission Life International Board members ritually wash and dry the chiropractors hands and then apply oil to the chiropractors palms. The Blessing of the Hands ceremony consists of pouring warm water gently scented with essential oil over hands as a symbol to refresh and renew the spirit. As each chiropractic hands are washed, the words, May your hands be blessed and may this water symbolize God's love for you, pouring upon you and what you do..." May your spirit of compassion and gentleness guide your hands." Finally, oil is applied to the chiropractors palms with the words, "Oh God, extend your blessing on everything you have given us — our family, health, money, land, friends and community. Give us peace in every way." "May your hands bring comfort and promote healing to all who come into your care".
