12:05 PM: Haiti Chiropractic mission trip begins in Cap Haitien, Haiti. We will have a bus and a car awaiting us at the CAP airport.

1:30 PM: Supermarket. We will stop at a supermarket for any last-minute supplies needed. You can buy water and snacks such as peanut butter, bread, and chocolate. Also, you will need toilet paper and personal items such as shampoo and soap. Note: The UN military base has a state of the art water purification system. The water at the base is as good as bottled water. Every day we will refill our bottles at the UN base before we have adjusting sessions.

2:30 PM: Travel over the most beautiful Mountains with awesome views of the ocean on the way to Labadee.

3:00 PM: Board four (4) small boats that will take us to the small village of Labadee, Haiti. This is a paradise village set amid spectacular mountains and lush foliage. There are no cars, motorcycles or any moving vehicles at this remote fishing village.



4:00 PM: Arrive in Labadee. Get settled.
