Haiti

The 5 day Haiti chiropractic mission trip begins on Monday March 28, 2016 and ends on April 1, 2016. The 7 day trip begins on Monday March 28 and ends on April 3, 2016. You must book a flight to and from Hugo Chávez International Airport (formerly Cap-Haïtien International Airport) (Airport code: CAP) This is the airport serving Cap-Haïtien. It is the second largest airport in Haiti. This airport connects Haiti to airports like Miami International Airport. We will pick you up at the airport.

The Haiti trip does include breakfast, lunch and dinner; however it does not include lunch for the first and last day. We have cooks who prepare us all the food and it will be cooked in bottled water. While in Haiti do not eat any food or water that is not directed by us. The trip includes all ground transportation, technique and philosophy workshops and the ability to serve thousands of people. ***
